## Registration opens on Friday, September 16, 2011

The Event Fee of \$115.00 includes two nights lodging and four meals (3 on Saturday and 1 on Sunday), t-shirt, and program expenses. This fee applies to all youth and adult participants.

## Important Things to Know About Registration

---

- 1) Registration for Youthquakes will be conducted on a "first-come, first-served" basis.
  - a) When a camp is filled, remaining registrations will be placed on a Waiting List, unless a Group chooses to move to an alternate date.
  - b) Registrations will not be considered complete until a check is received with the emailed registration.
- 2) All registrations will be made online at [www.regonline.com/yqfall2011](http://www.regonline.com/yqfall2011).

- 3) Registrations will **open** September 16, 2011  
Registrations will **close** October 21 for Youthquake #1  
Registrations will **close** October 28 for Youthquake #2
- 4) In registering, groups will reserve spots by providing names of the youth and adults attending.
  - a) On the closing date for the event (two weeks before the event begins), all spaces purchased become non-refundable. Prior to this date, a \$15 non-refundable fee will be kept for any cancelled spots.
  - b) Substitutions can be made but should be male-for-male and female-for-female. If a female youth or sponsor drops out, they need to be replaced with a female, and the same for males.
- 5) As they are registered, groups will receive a preliminary confirmation email of their registration.
- 6) After full payment has been received, a final confirmation email will be sent. This email will be needed to check-in your group at Youthquake

## Background checks

Background checks are required by Grace Presbytery, our insurance carriers, and the camp site. Please make sure that these checks are completed well in advance of your trip to Youthquake. Your group's Registration cannot be finalized until this is done!

## Scholarship Assistance
