Dr. Fallin (LMFT, LPC, Ph.D.) maintains a fulltime psychotherapy practice in the mid-cities area; he works primarily with marriage and family issues. Prior to receiving his doctorate in 1991, Dr. Fallin served as an ordained Methodist minister. Dr. Fallin is also part-time professor of direct practice courses in the graduate school of Social Work at the University of Texas at Arlington. The text for Dr. Fallin's address — "Divine Designs for Transitions" — is Ecclesiastes 3:1-8.

Dr. McCoy is a familiar face in Presbyterian circles and beyond. A retired Presbyterian minister, he most recently served as Theologian in Residence at Highland Park Presbyterian Church. 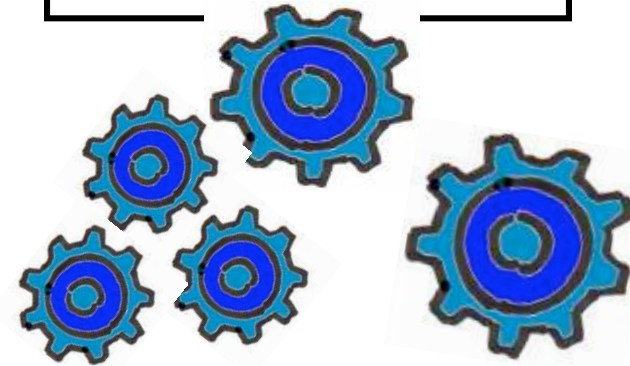
