# Registration Information

- 1) Adult advisors and youth must register as a group. Youth who wish to participate in SHYC but are not part of a youth group are encouraged to link up with another church. - 2) Registrations will not be considered complete until payment (credit card or check) is received.

**Early Registration will close January 17, 2022**  
**Late Registration starts January 18, 2022**
- 5) Information Needed to Register:

  - b) Church & City
  - c) Sex
  - d) Grade
  - e) T-Shirt
  - f) Special Needs
  - g) Food Allergies
- 6) On the closing date, **January 18, 2022**, all spaces purchased become non-refundable.
- 7) Any additions, substitutions or cancellations can be made online until registration closes on January 17<sup>th</sup>. Any additions, substitutions or cancellations starting January 18, 2022 need to be made at SHYC registration on Friday evening January 28, 2022 using the "**Drop/Add Form**" attached to the SHYC Confirmation Packet that you will receive via email confirming your registration.
- 8) As they are registered, groups will receive a preliminary confirmation email of their registration.
- 9) Adult Advisor Background checks are required by Grace Presbytery. Please make sure that these checks are completed and mailed to the Presbytery office by January 24, 2022. Your group's Registration cannot be finalized until this is done!
- 10) After full payment has been received and your attending Adult Advisors have been cleared by background checks a Confirmation Letter will be emailed to your registrar. This Confirmation Letter will be needed to check-in your group at SHYC 2022.
- 11) Scholarships are available for youth who have financial concerns. Contact Gary Holloman at the Grace Presbytery office (214-393-5617, or 800-678-4502 ext. 5617; [gary@gracepresbytery.org](mailto:gary@gracepresbytery.org) ) for more information.
- 12) Each church must send 1 adult advisor for every 7 youth, or any portion thereof. Each church must send at least 1 female and 1 male adult advisor unless the church's participants are all of the same gender. In that case, groups are still advised to bring 2 adults, in order to comply with Child Protection Policies. Adult advisors must be at least 21 years of age.

## **COVID PRECAUTIONS**

### **COVID Policy for Camps:**

1. All youth self-monitor for 1 week before trip event. Parents will need to monitor temperatures and inform youth sponsors. It will be the youth sponsors responsibility to follow up with the parents.
2. On date of leaving, youth sponsors will take temperatures before leaving for camp.
3. Every morning, youth sponsor will check youth temperatures and monitor for any COVID symptoms.
4. While at the event if a student shows COVID symptoms, their youth sponsor will contact the medical professional that is either on site or at the local Emergency Center close by. The youth sponsor and the medical professional will make a determination on what the next steps are. Grace Presbytery will have rapid home COVID test on site to administer at the medical professional's discretion.

### **COVID Exposure Policy:**

1. If the student's school contacts the parents to state their student was possibly exposed at school and the student does NOT need to quarantine, then the student is ok to travel to the event. If they do need to quarantine, then they will need to cancel, and a full refund given.
2. If student has been directly exposed in the last 10 days, they will need to cancel, and a full refund given. This includes anyone in the home that has tested positive in the last 10 days.

### **While at camp:**

1. Masks will be worn at all times while inside.
2. Small Groups
  - a. Will be held outside as much as possible with weather permitting.
  - b. Social distancing as much as possible.
3. Meals
  - a. Meals will be in home groups at tables and tables are spaced out as much as possible.
4. Sleeping arrangements
  - a. Youth will stay in home groups.
5. Large Group time
  - a. Will be held outside as much as possible with weather permitting.

### **Recommendations**

1. Negative test within 72 hours or be fully vaccinated is recommended, but not required unless the home congregation requires it
